Dear Parents/Carers

COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Procedures

Can I remind parents/carers that if their child is showing any signs of being unwell, including a runny nose or other 'minor' illnesses, please do not send them into school. We continue to monitor the health of every child on arrival each day to ensure they are fit to be at school. Obviously, we have a responsibility to maintain the health of all other attendees; staff and pupils.

In particular, if your child is showing any signs of the virus, namely a continuous cough or high temperature, you must keep your child away from school. Parents/Carers should go online to NHS 111 (or call 111 if you don't have internet access). In an emergency you should call 999 if your child is seriously ill. You should not visit the GP, pharmacy, urgent care centre or a hospital.

Should your child be taken unwell during the school day, again in line with Department for Education (DfE) and Public Health England (PHE) advice, we will immediately isolate them from others and ring home to have them picked up.

As you can imagine, we are practising stringent cleaning and health and safety measures in order to ensure the safety of all present. This includes, as suggested by the DfE and PHE, frequently cleaning and disinfecting objects and surfaces that are touched regularly.

We strongly urge that all parents adhere to the government guidance regarding staying at home and away from others (social distancing) when their child is not in school, e.g. evenings and weekends. This guidance has been implemented in order to protect the NHS and ultimately save lives.
