Playground Opening During the Break

Once again we will be opening our playgrounds to parents/carers of children within our infant and junior departments.

The playgrounds will be open between 9am and 12pm on Wednesday 29th May.

A staff member will be on hand however, parents/carers are responsible for the supervision and support of their own children. Whilst we will have toilets for children to use, we are unable to provide any drinks or snacks. If any parent/carer would like to bring anything with them, they are more than welcome.

Reporting Absence

When a child is absent from school, parents/carers should phone into the school office by 9.00am on the first morning of absence and keep the school updated on a daily basis of any further absence. **Any absence not reported in this way has to be recorded as 'unauthorised'**. This is a safeguarding requirement in order that all parties know that children are safe and their whereabouts are known. In cases where a child's whereabouts are unknown, this could result in a visit from the Family Liaison Officer.



Can we remind parents/carers that absence should not be reported on ClassDojo, or through drivers/escorts.



Royal Academy Young Artists Summer Show

We have heard back from the Royal Academy of Arts regarding the work submitted for the Royal Academy Young Artists' Summer Show. Unfortunately, none of the art work submitted was selected as a winner however, we thought that each piece was deserving of recognition. Each of the pupils/students will be receiving a certificate from the Royal Academy noting their participation in the competition.

Communication

Over the past 7 years we have been working alongside The Balanced System to gain and maintain our "Centre of Excellence for Communication" Award. This award recognises our commitment to supporting Communication in our school setting and beyond.

As a result of this project we recognised that a fully co-ordinated approach is the way forward - I am excited to be able to develop this new full-time role to enable and support everyone to develop communication at Foreland Fields.

I have an overview of all matters related to Speech, Language and Communication Needs (SLCN), including how these needs are best met within our curriculum pathways. This includes developing Literacy and a love for reading.



I work closely with our staff team, parents/carers, our link NHS S< provision and the KMCAT Team to ensure a 'total communication' approach is available across the school and our satellite provisions.

I am also a Regional Makaton tutor providing training both in-house and in the local community. The highlight of my week is leading the school signing choir sessions for students and staff.

We have a sign of the week in school and are currently developing special booklets of signs for our off-site activities.
